## Registration Process

We invite members to register their children during the week of April 20th. Registration forms must be **mailed** in order to confirm placement in a sailing class. We have space available for 10 children in each class. Most weeks we will offer both our 1/2 day Junior Optimist (Optis) camp for 8-10 year olds along with our full day sailing class for 11-14 year olds. Beginning May 1st we will open up the registration to non-members. We encourage sailing campers to sign up with a friend or a group of friends, it creates an engaging, fun environment for everyone out on the water. Campers will understand the fundamentals of sailing by the end of the week and have fun while learning. All students will also receive a LBC Sailing T Shirt, always a popular item. Please be aware that we do all we can to accommodate your first choice on the requested dates, however due to the popularity of the program and the limited class sizes we do fill up quickly so don't delay completing your registration .

### General Program Offering

#### Junior 1/2 day Opti camp for 8-10 year olds

Students will sail in Optimist sail boats which will be more appropriate to their size and sailing level. Especially designed for the beginner sailor we will include a separate morning session from 9:00am -12:00 noon and the afternoon session from 1:00pm - 4:00pm, 5 days a week. Both sessions each day are identical. Your child can sail the week in the mornings or the afternoons depending on their summer schedule and yours too!

#### Junior full day camp for 11-14 year olds

Students will sail Bytes and or Lasers and will go a full day from 9:00-4:00 five days a week. This class will be a mix of first time sailors and returning students and has always been a popular class for general sailing and enhancing skills.

#### Advanced sailing/Intro to racing sessions for 11-14 year olds

Students who are ready to advance their skills and have sailed with us, or a comparable program for at least 2 years. Introduction to racing will be covered and will conclude in a race the final day. Minimum age is 11 years old. **Please refer to the schedule on the front page for the particular dates and times.**

The LBC is delighted to welcome back last years sailing staff led by Keaton Kinnaman. Keaton has been involved with the LBC sailing program for the past 6 years and knows it well. We also welcome back Jake Zolotusky to build on another year. Two more instructors will finish off this group of experienced sailors who all have First Aid training, CPR and hold a US Sailing Level 1 certificate for instruction. To support our sailing fleet the LBC maintains two powerboats to ensure a safe and well patrolled sailing program. Life jackets are mandatory for all students and instructors at all times. Parents should know that their child will have to perform a swim test the first day, so come prepared that day to get wet! Students must be able to pass this swim test in order to participate in the camp that week. More information on the entire week will be sent to the family prior to attending the week they have signed up, regarding what to bring and answer any questions you may have. We look forward to another great summer of fun sailing at the LBC as we continue the sailing tradition since 1939.
